We started off delivering just gasoline and diesel but today we also transport biodiesel, crude oil, waste vegetable oil, motor oil, dry van products, shipping containers just to mention a few. We anticipate Bakersfield becoming one of our largest terminals in a very short time. We are on schedule for Bakersfield operations to begin March 1st, 2014. We are off to a great start due to PTL held a recent job fair at the new Bakersfield vard which brought great interest and we have already hired several drivers. The department's objective is to keep our equipment always running in an operationally safe condition for not only our drivers but for our environment and the public at large. This department integrates scheduled maintenance programs, random inspections and timely repairs to keep our equipment running well which enables us to provide the safe quality service our customers come to expect. Our fleet department is called upon to take care of the trucks at any time of day or wherever the truck may be located. - Assure that the interlocks (buttons) on load and dump valves are released after loading and off loading.
- ✓ Make sure all fittings are placed into the fitting box.
